Legendary Sports Prints To Honor Ripken in Lithograph

To Feature Star that is First Year Eligible to Hall of Fame

Plantville, CT – December 21st, 2006 – Legendary Sports Prints (LSP) announced today its intention to honor Cal Ripken, Jr. in a special limited edition lithograph based on an original painting. The lithograph will be licensed by Ironclad Authentics (www.ironcladauthentics.com), a Ripken Baseball, Inc. affiliate, and will be co-marketed by LSP and Ironclad Authentics.

Cal Ripken, Jr., was a two-time American League Most Valuable Player and proved to be the most durable everyday player in baseball history, having played in a record twenty-six hundred and thirty two (2632) consecutive Major League baseball games. Ripken will be first time eligible for induction into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown, NY in 2007. The lithograph will be a reproduction of a hand painting that is currently being completed by renowned sports artist Bill Purdom.

“We are thrilled to work with Ironclad Authentics on this project and honored to depict a true gentleman and sports hero in Cal Ripken, Jr.,” said Vincent Furfaro, LSP’s Senior Vice President and Co-Founder. “We envision a truly special print by combining the world class talents of artist Bill Purdom with the legendary status of such a baseball icon as Cal Ripken, Jr.” Ripken retired having played in a total of 3001 games (8th all-time), and amassing 3,184 hits (13th all-time), 431 career homers (30th all-time) and held or shared 11 Major League or American League fielding records.

“We are proud to be associated with Legendary Sports Prints and believe that the sports art that they produce appeal to sports collectors, art enthusiasts and people who share a passion for the various classic sports moments they have recreated,” said Raymond M Schulte, General Manager of Ironclad Authentics. “I am excited at the vision they have to honor Cal and look forward to a lithograph that is entirely unique and that stands alone in recognition of Cal’s accomplishments,” Mr. Schulte added.

The print is expected to include various cherished moments in Cal Ripken, Jr.'s baseball history such as his record breaking consecutive game streak and the 1983 World Series won by the Baltimore Orioles. In addition, the print will be licensed by Ironclad Authentics, The Baseball Hall of Fame, and Major League Baseball. It is expected that the print will be available both autographed by Cal Ripken, Jr. as well as unsigned. Edition size and suggested retail prices have not yet been determined. Many of LSP's past lithographs are available for sale on Ironclad Authentics' web site.

This print is expected to become available in mid-January, in time for Ironclad Authentics' mega-event, "Baseball's Best" in Baltimore, Maryland on January 26th through January 28th, 2007 (<http://www.baseballsbest2007.com>).
